#### Vocabulary Recommendations

Choose from the following vocabulary entries:

**verbatim** - the alternative resource is a verbatim caption of audio in the referenced resource

**reduced** - the described resource is a reduced reading level caption of the audio in the referenced resource.

**enhanced** - the described resource is an enhanced caption of audio in the referenced resource; enhanced captions may contain or include images, graphics, links to external resources, etc. that helps communicate the content of the audio in greater detail

**real-time** - the described resource is real-time audio, video, etc.

**transcript** - the described resource is a verbatim textual representation of the speech in the referenced resource

**alternative text** - the described resource is a short text description of an image, specifically ALT text

**long description** - the described resource is a long textual description of an image, specifically LONGDESC

**talking book** - the described resource is a recording of the contents of a book read aloud

**Daisy** - the described resource is an electronic book that conforms to the Daisy specification ([www.daisy.org](http://www.daisy.org))

**image-based** - the described resource is an image-based representation of the intellectual content of the referenced resource, for example, graphs, pictures, photographs, etc.

**symbolic** - the described resource is a symbolic representation of the intellectual content of the referenced resource, for example, musical notation, Bliss, etc.

**recorded** - the described resource is recorded audio

**synthesized** - the described resource is synthesized audio

**Braille** - the described resource is braille

**haptic** - the described resource is tactile content that requires a sense of touch
